



Kamala likes to paint

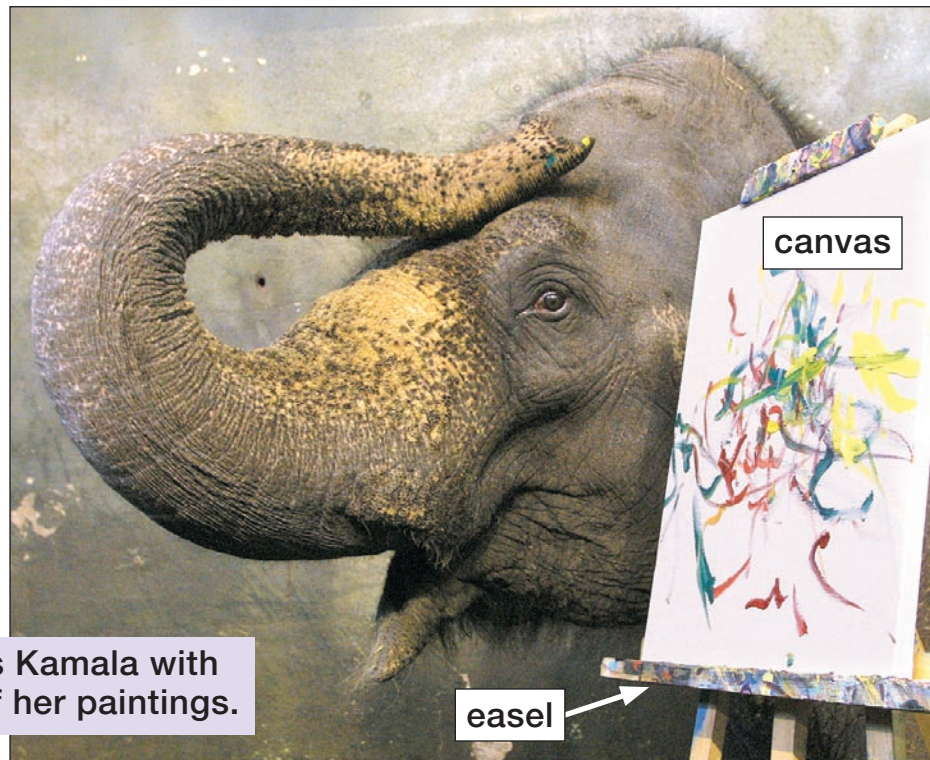

The zoo sells Kamala's paintings for \$400 and up. The money helps run the zoo. Some of the money pays for special activities for the animals.
