Our tutors are patient, reliable, non-judgmental and willing to give about 2 hours per week for at least one year. Tutoring takes place at a safe, public location that is convenient for both the tutor and learner, such as a local library or coffee shop, or at our Centre. Some of our volunteers facilitate group classes as well.

We provide our volunteers with free training, resources, and ongoing support. This is a truly meaningful way to make a difference in our community.
