

Adult Class Facilitator

Summary

Adult Class Facilitators work in partnership with the Centre for Family Literacy to provide opportunities for adult learners to reach their literacy goals. Our classes are warm, welcoming, safe environments in which adults find meaningful community and learning opportunities.

Responsibilities

- Plan for each 8-week session (with CFL staff and a co-facilitator) and adapt plans as needed to accommodate the needs of the participants
- Facilitate/Co-facilitate weekly sessions for participants
- Assist participants with goal-setting and learning at their pace
- Maintain records including intake forms, evaluation forms and volunteer hours
- Provide updates on successes and challenges to the Volunteer Coordinator and Adult Learning Coordinator, and seek support as needed
- Write a brief report at the end of each session

Skills and Oualifications

- A desire to see individuals and families flourish through the enjoyment of literacy
- The ability to receive direction and work independently on a variety of tasks
- Able to effectively teach in a group setting, facilitate group discussions, and help to foster increased skill and confidence in a diverse group of adult learners

Time Commitment

Two hours per week facilitating plus time for preparation
