Reference Letters

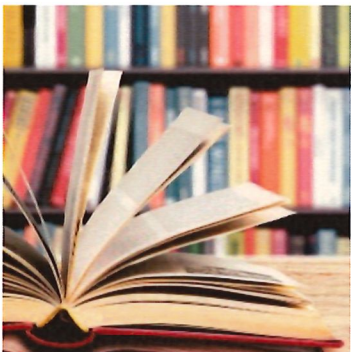
