Chime Live

The Literacy and Learning Symposium is a whirlwind of networking, learning and celebrating. Be sure to manage your own time and energy so you get the most out of your time with us.

NEW* Custom Chime Live Virtual Platform: Each attendee will be given access to our Chime Live virtual event platform, which will provide all the information, activities and entertainment that you will need for a great virtual Symposium experience. Our customized virtual platform will have schedules of daily events, a **Main Stage** for livestream events, such as the CLN AGM, the Opening, Awards, and Closing Ceremonies, the keynote presentations and more. This is also where you will find the links to **Zoom breakout session links** for your sessions based on your personal agendas.

You will be given access to the virtual platform via your **email and a pre-set password**, which will be sent to you. **Note:** Your password to access the event will be automatically generated, and will NOT be the same as your CALP Portal password.

There will also be engagement features built into the virtual platform for networking opportunities.

You can also stop by the **virtual Symposium registration and information desk** (via a Zoom link) if you have any questions.

Each day, login to **Chime Live** and we will provide announcements about the day's events, countdowns to the main events and more! Be sure to join us at 8:45 am each day – we'll help set the stage for the day, and there will be DOOR PRIZES!

IMPORTANT NOTE: To get the most of the full Virtual Symposium experience, be sure to keep Chime Live open throughout the event. There is no need to close Chime Live when you log into meetings or sessions. Chime Live will be used to share messages, send important updates, and as our "plenary room".



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Sessions via Zoom

Sessions at this year's Symposium will be held using the Zoom platform.

Within the Chime Live event site, you will have access to your personal agenda, and direct links to log in to your sessions via Zoom.

Virtual Symposium Orientation
