**Custom Chime Live Virtual Platform:** Each attendee will be given access to our Chime Live virtual event platform, which will provide all the information, activities and entertainment that you will need for a great virtual Symposium experience. Our customized virtual platform will have schedules of daily events, a **Main Stage** for livestream events such as the Opening and Closing, the keynote presentation, the Adult Learner Speaker and more. This is also where you will find the links to **Zoom breakout session links** for your sessions based on your personal agendas.
