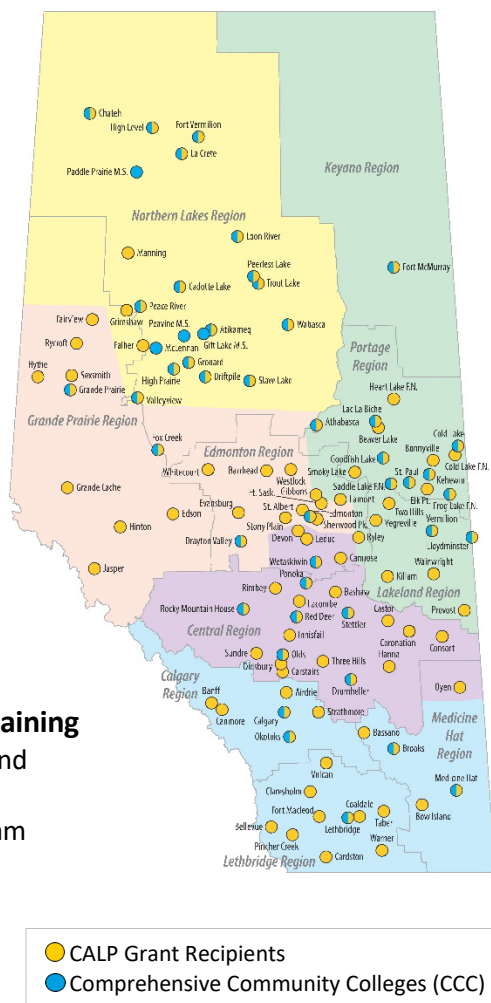
### CALP Database
